

Your application to volunteer with Edukid has been successful and you are now officially enrolled as a volunteer under Edukid's Global Citizenship Award Programme.

This is a remote programme, so you can complete your volunteer tasks from wherever you are based in the world. You can choose to work independently on the tasks, or you can choose to work in a small group to complete your volunteer hours. If you are working as a group, please make sure all members of the group have enrolled on the programme.

If you are doing your volunteering for the DofE's awards, you must appoint an assessor (e.g. a form tutor or a teacher you see regularly) to sign off your work each week. This can be done using the EDOFE app or in person using our tick sheet.
